# Welcome to the ABW Impact Accelerator Application!

Thank you for your interest in the Analytics for a Better World (ABW) Impact Accelerator Program. This program supports mission-driven organizations that seek to unlock the power of analytics and AI to accelerate their impact toward the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in low- and middle-income countries (LMICs).

Before we dive into the questions, please ensure that:

- Your organization is mission-driven (nonprofit, social enterprise, or public-interest consortium),
- Legally established and operating for at least two years,
- Aligned with at least one SDG,
- Has leadership commitment and a cross-functional team ready to participate,
- And your proposed challenge is central to your mission and suitable for analytics or AI.

A quick reminder: don't worry about writing perfect answers. This application is designed to help us get to know you, your organization, your vision and your challenge.

A quick note before you start: This application should take about 20 minutes to complete. Think of it as the time it takes to enjoy a good coffee break, and don't worry: you don't have to do it all in one go. You can start now, save your progress, and come back to finish later when inspiration strikes.

# Consortiums Welcome! Here's How You Can Apply Together:

If you're a **group of organizations** applying as a consortium, we'd love to see that collaborative spirit! Just make sure to include in the application:

- One Application: Submit one combined application
- One Lead Organization: Choose a main point of contact and leading entity
- **Group Overview**: Briefly introduce all participating organizations
- **Shared Challenge**: Tell us how this challenge brings you together and how each organization contributes to the solution
- **Collective Impact Plan**: How will you collaborate, share knowledge, and keep things moving smoothly?

Tip! You can add consortium-related details in each section (e.g. team bios, sustainability plan, data capacity) by labeling which org is responsible for which part.
